

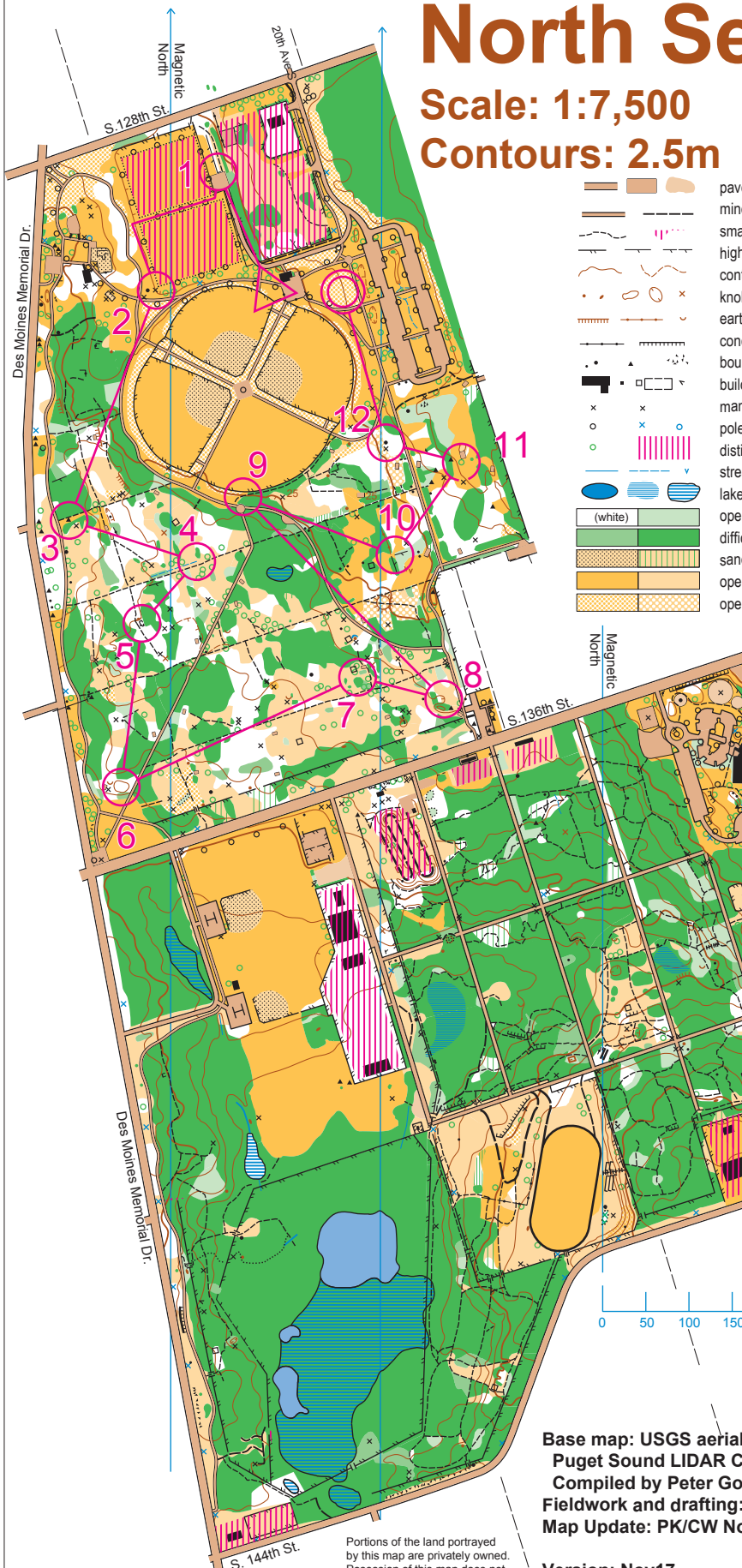
# North Seatac Park
