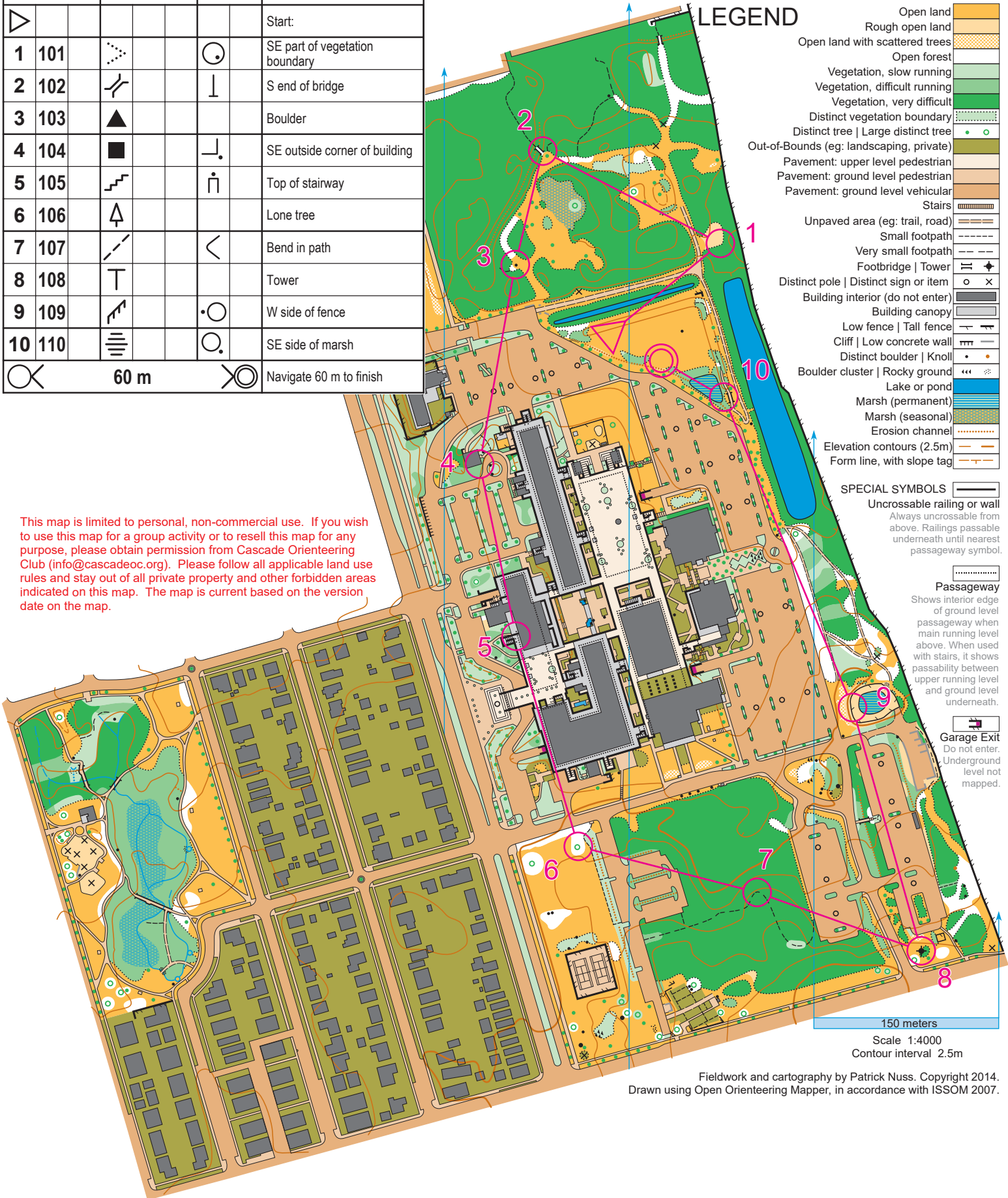

SPECIAL SYMBOLS

Uncrossable railing or wall
Always uncrossable from above. Railings passable underneath until nearest passageway symbol.

Passageway
Shows interior edge of ground level passageway when main running level above. When used with stairs, it shows passability between upper running level and ground level underneath.

Garage Exit
Do not enter. Underground level not mapped.
