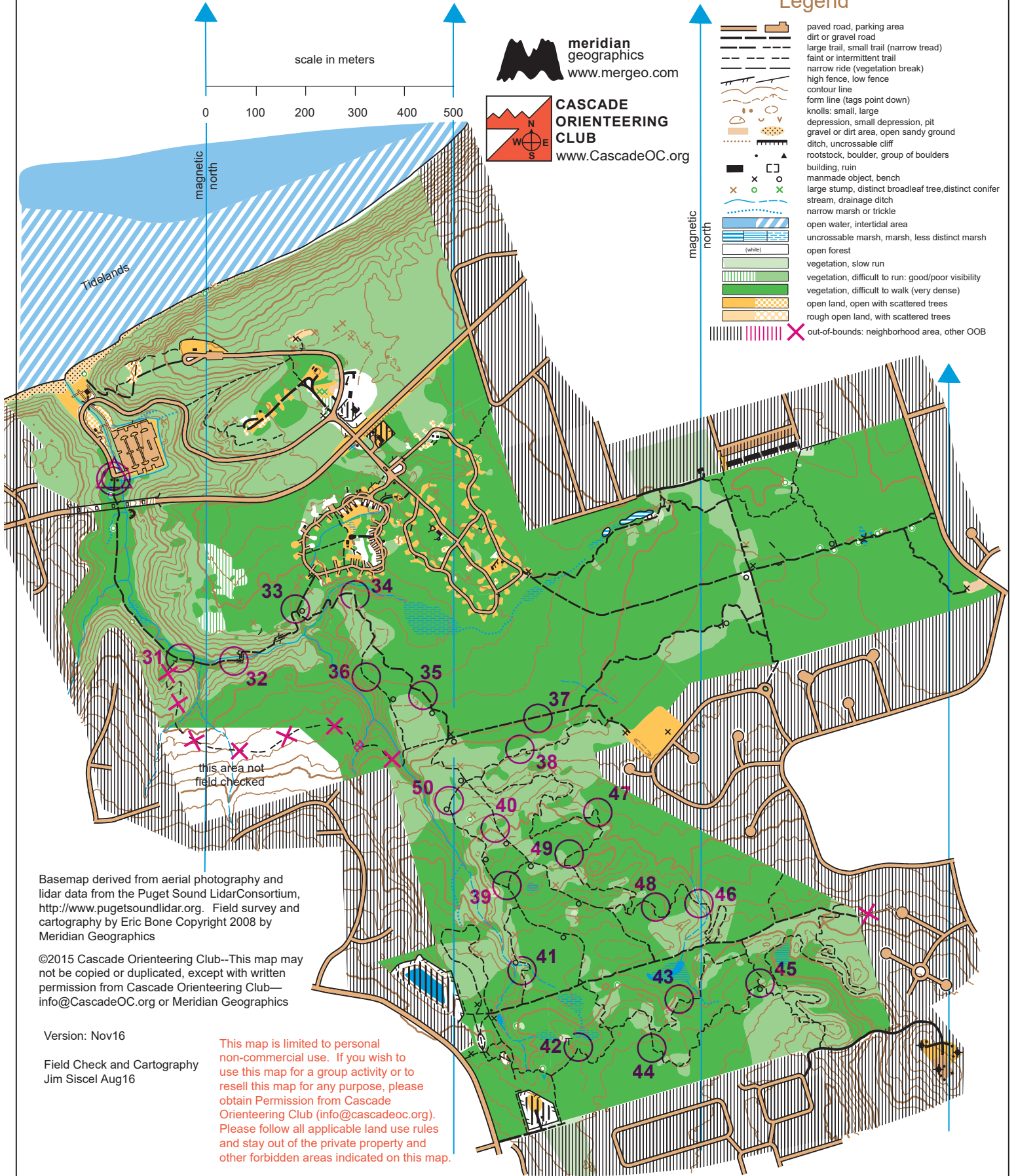


# Dash Point State Park

- knolls: small, large
- depression, small depression, pit
- gravel or dirt area, open sandy ground
- ditch, uncrossable cliff
- rootstock, boulder, group of boulders
- building, ruin
- manmade object, bench
- large stump, distinct broadleaf tree, distinct conifer
- stream, drainage ditch
- narrow marsh or trickle
- open water, intertidal area
- uncrossable marsh, marsh, less distinct marsh
- open forest
- vegetation, slow run
- vegetation, difficult to run: good/poor visibility
- vegetation, difficult to walk (very dense)
- open land, open with scattered trees
- rough open land, with scattered trees
- out-of-bounds: neighborhood area, other OOB
